SUMMARY

CCED contains data about California easements over both public and private property. More than 2 million acres of land are now inventoried in CCED. This total is made up of nearly 12,000 separate easements managed by 215 government agencies, non-profits, and other organizations*.

RANKINGS OF ACRES, AGENCIES

Top 10 agencies hold 68.9 percent of all **acres** in CCED

The other 205 agencies hold 86.1 percent of **easements** (count) in CCED

The **median** size of all easements in CCED is 2.8 acres. The **mean** size is 171 acres.

*CCED contains three "Unknown" agency domains – one for general easements where esmthldr is unknown, one for unknown easements reported by the San Diego Association of Governments, and one for unknown easements reported by the San Diego Geographic Information Source. These three "Unknown" agency domains represent more than three separate agencies.

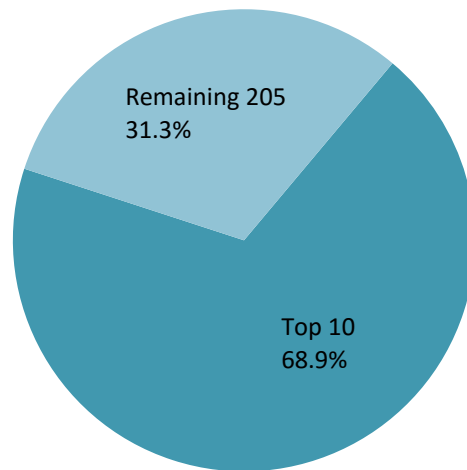

Top 10 Agencies

There are 215 agencies and organizations with holdings in CCED. Of those, the top 10 hold 1,395,360 acres (68.9%) of the 2,025,114 total acres of easements in CCED. The remaining 205 agencies and organizations hold 629,754 acres (31.1%) of easements combined.
